Wiltshire Inmates of Gloucester Gaol 1815-1879

Many criminals from those parishes on county borders would be sent to magistrates and assizes courts out of county. This would be the case in most crimes carried out in a neighbouring county. Several men and women would therefore find themselves sentenced to prison terms which they would serve within the county gaol of the trial court. The following are those sentenced to prison terms in the Gloucester County Gaol.
