(in the chair) and a full bench of Magistrates, among whom were – the Earl Suffolk, Lord Ernest Bruce, Messrs Long, Neeld, Sotheron, Heneage, Walter, Poulett Scrope, T. Phipps, Warrener, A. Goddard, Col. Wroughton, Col. Vilett, J. Calley, Ravenhill, H. N. Goddard, F. Locke, Bythesea, Jacob, Smith, Graves, H. L. Popham. Morris, the Rev. Messrs Goddard, William, Hawkins, &c.

Baverstock Parish – Pursuant to notice given, application was made to the Court, that the parish of Baverstock be annexed to, and form part of, the division of Salisbury and Amesbury, instead of Hindon. It was unanimously agreed that it should be so annexed.
