Married, on Wednesday, the 19th inst., at Baverstock, W. H. B. Earle, Esq., of Holton, Oxfordshire, to Anne, daughter of the late Rev. N. Earl, of Swerford, in the same county.

Married – May 2 at Baverstock Church, by the Rev. W. E. Hony, Mr Musekwhite, Officer of Excise, Tisbury, to Sarah, eldest daughter of Mr Nowlson, of Hurdcott Farm.

Married, June 26, at Baverstock, by the Lord Bishop of Bath and Wells, the Rev. Thomas Garrett, third son of the late T. Garrett, Esq., of Ellington, Kent, to Joanna, second daughter of Alex. Powell, Esq., of Hurdcott, Wilts.

Married, Nov. 7, at Baverstock, by the Rev. Geo. Powell, the Rev. Charles Raikes Davy, only son of Lieut. General Sir Wm. G. Davy, C.B. & K.C.H., of Tracy Park, Gloucestershire, to Catherine Augusta, youngest daughter of Alexander Powell, Esq., of Hurdcott, Wilts. and grand-daughter of the Lord Bishop of Bath and Wells.

Married, July 21, at Wilton, by the Rev. Mr Sutton, Mr Nowlson, of Horpsfield Hall, Herts. To Mrs Smith, widow of Mr Smith, of Baverstock.

Married, on the 21st inst., at Baverstock Church, by the Rev. G. Powell, Mr Stephen Watts, of that place, to Miss Leah Bungey, of Burcombe, in this county.

Married, at Baverstock, on Thursday, May 20, by the Ven. Archdeacon Hony, Mr Thomas Sweatman, of Dinton, to Miss Shipman, eldest daughter of the late Mr M. Shipman, of the former place.

DEATHS

On Sunday last died Mr T. Knowlson, a respectable famer at Baverstock, near this city.

A few days since died Mrs Smith, widow of Mr J. Smith, late a respectable farmer, of Baverstock, in this county.

Died, Rev. R. H. Hitchens, A.M. rector of Baverstock Wilts. On the 9th Inst. at Rome, in the 27th year of his age.

On Tuesday last died at Baverstock, Mr Smith, a respectable farmer, in his 58th year, much respected by all who knew him.

On Monday the 8th inst. died at Baverstock, aged 18, of pulmonary consumption, Clementina Jane, youngest daughter of the late Mr John Nowlson.

Died, on Sunday, the 24th of March, much respected, Mrs Smith, late of Baverstock Farm, aged 63.

Died at Baverstock Rectory, on Wednesday, July 24, the Rev. Charles Hare Erle, in the 39th year of his age.

Died – July 24, at Baverstock Rectory, the Rev. Charles Hare Erle, in the 29th year of his age.

(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 1 August, 1839)

Died, on Tuesday last, in his 32nd year, Mr James Smith, of Baverstock Farm, much respected and regretted by his friends.

Died, on Saturday, May 22, after a very short illness, Mrs Sarah Read of Baverstock, in her 84th year, much respected.
