



Devizes Green Fair

Usually held on the 20th of October, but that day falling on Sunday, it will be held on the Monday following, (lately rented by **John Painter**, deceased, but now by **William Read**, of Roundway).

ALL persons who usually had sheep pennis, standings, or stalls, yearly, in the fair, and would chuse to keep the same, are desired to apply at the *Widow Hale's*, the sign of the Royal Oak, on the aforesaid Green, in proper time; where the said William Read, or some other person, authorised to lett the same, will give Attendance. And all other persons who shall have occasion for the like, are desired to apply at the same place.

Standings and stalls will be erected in proper time, so that no person may have occasion for evading the Tolls that ought to be paid, which of late years has been too much the practice of some.
