1846

January 13. Near Highworth, Wilts, the Rev. George Thomas of Bishopstone. When out with the Vale of White Horse Hounds, apparently in good health and spirits and crossing a field at a foot-pace, he suddenly fell from off his horse and expired. He was but recently married. 1847

Death On the 1st January last, at Bishopstone (North Wilts), Mr. Edward Curtis, aged 69.
