

Obituary George Westell of Bishopstone, 1893

Death of Geo. Westell

Death has removed from this village a familiar figure in the person of Mr. Geo. Westell, who was for some years the owner and occupier of the True heart Inn, Bishopstone. On the death of his wife a year or two ago he gave up the public house and lived retired. He had for some months suffered from a diseased foot which became so bad that amputation was considered necessary, but this the sufferer objected to, and he succumbed to his illness on Sunday morning, the 3rd inst. he leaves a grownup family.

In addition to being landlord of the True Heart Inn for so many years, deceased was also a farmer and dealer, and was well known in Swindon market.

The funeral took place at the Parish Church, Bishopstone, on Thursday in last week, and was attended by members of deceased's family, and also by members of the Loyal "true heart" Lodge of Oddfellows, to which deceased had belonged for many years. The service was impressively conducted by the Vicar, the Rev. H. Ault.
