The traffic mark is registered according to law; to copy or imitate which is forgery. Licensed Victuallers and Wine Merchants only are eligible as Agents to the Association. A sample Parcel of Eight Pounds forwarded carriage free, on receipt of Post Office Order. All communications to be made direct, the services of Travellers having been discontinued. The Teas are very strong and wholesome, are guaranteed pure of uniform quality, and are used and approved by all classes.
