A marriage between Miss E. L. Povey, second daughter of Mr. John Povey, of Bishopstone, and Mr. W. W. Saunders of Little Hinton, took place on Wednesday morning at the Parish Church. The bride wore a beautiful dress of cream cachemire with train, also a wreath of orange blossoms and tulle veil, and carried a lovely bouquet. She was given away by her father, and attended by her sisters the Misses F. and C. Povey, and also the Misses L. and L. Saunders sisters of the bridegroom, as bridesmaids. Mr. Frank Povey figured as best man. The bridesmaids were prettily dressed, and each carried a choice bouquet. The Rev. H. Ault, vicar, conducted the service, which was choral, and Miss Richards, Hinton, officiated at the organ.

A number of guests attended the ceremony and were entertained by the bride's parents. As the bridal party proceeded from the church, a merry peal from the bells greeted them.
