The Rev. Dr Rowland Williams, author of the article Bunsen's Biblical Researchers, in Essays and Reviews, advertises in the Record for a clergymen to take charge of the district of Bowerchalke, a portion of the large parish of Broad Chalke, of which he is vicar. "Desired," says Dr Williams, "a good preacher, with musical skill and nothing odd in doctrine. Rational or Ritual eccentricity objected to."
