BREMILHAM or COWAGE, a small parish in the hundred, Union and parliamentary borough of Malmesbury, from which place it lies 2 miles west-south-west and 10 north-west from Chippenham. The living is a rectory, valued at £150, in the diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, and the presentation of George Rushout Esq.; the Rev. Arthur Evias is the present rector, and the Rev. Lewis Way, M.A., is curate. The parish church is a small and very plain structure. R. S. Holford, Esq., is lord of the manor. The area is 490 acres, and the population 46.
