

Former Rector's Death

The Rev. John Leodric de Buckenhold Thorold, rector of Bromham from 1907 until 1931, died suddenly at Strathculd Hele, Exeter, last week. He succeeded the Rev. Gordon Smythe at Bromham, and was followed by the present Rector (the Rev. P. G. Phillips). He graduated at New College, Oxford and became curate of Oxted, Surrey in 1888, remaining there for two years. He was subsequently curate at Lambeth for one year and rector of Warkleigh with Satterleigh , Devon, from 1891 to 1907. During his ministry in Bromham he was greatly respected and some of the parishioners kept up a correspondence with him and Mrs. Thorold. The funeral was at Warkleigh on Saturday.
