He was bred up to the law, which he practised in the Temple from the year 1702 to the year 1730. In the year 1714 his late Majesty King George the First granted him for life the offices of Chief Clerk Register, and Sole Examiner in the Chancery of the Ifland of Barbados and clerk of the Crown and Clerk of the peace there, to be executed by his depuries. In the year 1715 he was appointed sollicitor for the affairs of his Majesty's Treasury, which office he executed with distinguished zeal & upright nefs for the Crown interest till the year 1730 when he voluntarily resign'd it, serving his King & Country afterwards as a member of Parliament; lastly, well considering the brevity of human life, he chose to retire from all publick businefs and settled in this Parish, devoting the remainder of his days in Religious attention to the only and most important businfs that of a future and happy immortality He died in the 72nd ward of his days in the ward of aur lard 1752
