

Extracts from Christian Malford Parish Register

1653

The fowerth day of December 1653, the first time published an Agreement of Marridge to be had between Abel Clarke, of Christian Malford, cordeweiner, and Joane Adley, of the parish of Dancie; on the eleventh day of the same moneth published the second time; the eighteenth day next published the same the third and last time.

1656

4th November - John Hulbert & France Hull; before William Shute at his house in Segary, and afterwards in the Parish Church by Mr. Will. Gough, minister, the day and year aforesaid, before a very great congregation. [signed] Will. Gough, Rector

1658-1659

4th January - Mr. Tho. Crapen. Master of Arts and Minister of the Gospell, in the County of Wilts., was married to Mrs. Fr. Witts, wid., the daughter of Rich. Shewell, according to the approved customs of the Kingdome, before very many witnesses, by me, Will. Gough, Rector of Christian Malford

1659-1665

There are no marriages entered between Oct. 1659 and Oct. 1665; nor Baptisms between March 1661/62 and Nov. 1665; nor Burials between Feb. 1661-62 and Nov. 1665

1701

A Scotchman found dead in ye water.

1707-1730

A Register of Moneys collected upon Briefs Grace the Act of Parliamt. made for that purpose Anno 4° & 5° Anna. Regina, in ye Parifh of Xian Malford

1733

A Vestry was held in the Parish Church of Xtian Malford the 15 day of February 1733/4 about Cieling the Church and the Votes stppd thus

For Cieling ye Church: Mr, Richd. Burgess, Francis Wheeler, John Smith, Richard Pinegar, Charles Trimnel, Matthew Hopkins, Joseph Pullen, Thomas Saunders,

Against Cieling yr Church: No body.
