Clyffe Pypard Tithe Awards

The Tithe Award is dated 1844

Tithe Awards were prepared pursuant to the Tithe Act of 1836. Their purpose was to replace the tithes which had hitherto been paid in kind or by composition into a rent charge on individual pieces of land.

Also known as Apportionment of the rent charge in lieu of tithes.

He deth hereby declare it to be his will and intent certified by his signature and sent hereunto annead that the said Tithes shall be absolutely merged and extinguished in the freehold and inheritance of the said lands.

The Right Honorable George William Frederick Earl of Clarendon is Improprietor of the Tithe of Corn Grain Hay and Wood arising from a Piece or parcel of land called Cliffe Wood situate in the said Parish containing by estimation Seventeen acres three rods and twenty poles.

The said Horatio Nelson Goddard is Improprietor of Tithes of Corn grain gay and wood from all the lands of the said parish except of the said Cliffe Wood and except the Tithe of hay arising from these lands whereof the Tithe of Hay is hereinbefore mentioned to be payable to the said Vicar.

It is hereby agreed that the amount sum of eighteen shillings by way of Rent Charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the said George William Frederick Earl of Clarendon his heirs and assigns instead of the Tithes of corn grain hay and wood arising from the said Cliffe Wood.

That the amount sum of four hundred and thirty five pounds by way of Rent Charge (subject as aforesaid) shall be paid to the said Horatio Nelson Goddard his heirs and assigns instead of the Tithes of corn grain hay and wood respectively arising from all the lands within the said parish of Cliffe Pypard (except the said Cliffe Wood and also except the lands the Tithes whereof respectively have been hereinbefore declared to be absolutely merged by the said Horatio Nelson Goddard.

Ind that the Annual sum of five hundred and ninety pounds byway of Rent Charge subject as aforesaid shall be paid to the said George Ashe Goddard as Vicar of the said Parish and to his successors instead of All the small Tithes of the lands of the said parish subject to Tithes including the Tithe of hay in those parts of the said Parish hereinbefore mentioned as subject to pay such tithes to him and instead of all moduses and compositions real and prescriptive and customary payments payable in respect of all lands of the said Parish or the produce thereof a summary description of which is contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed.

And it is further agreed that the lands of the said Parish shall be discharged from the payment of Tithes and the Rent Charge hereby agreed upon in lieu thereof shall commence and become payable from the first day of April next preceding the confirmation of the apportionment of the said Rent Charges.

In Testimony whereof the said Parties to these Presents or their respective Agents thereunto duly authorised in these names and on their behalf have to these presents subscribed and set their hands and seals.

Schedule to the above Articles of Agreement

The whole Parish of Cliffe Pypard aforesaid contains by estimation (exclusive of roads weirs brooks the sites of Dwelling houses and small gardens held therewith) Three thousand nine hundred and fourteen acres and one pole of land statute measure.

The whole quantity of the land of the said parish which is subject to the payment of any kind of Tithes is by estimation Three thousand nine hundred and fourteen acres and one pole of land statute measure.

whole quantity of the land subject to the payment of any kind of Tithes within the said parish which is cultivated as Arable is by estimation One thousand one hundred and ninety three acres two roods and three poles statute measure.

whole quantity of the land subject to any kind of Tithes within the said parish cultivated as Meadow or Pasture land is by estimation Two thousand six hundred and forty seven acres statute measure.

whole quantity of the land subject to any kind of Tithes within the said parish now cultivated as Wood-land is by estimation Seventy three acres one rood and 38 poles statute measure.

Glebe of the said parish consists of a Vicarage House and a Garden the property of the Vicar for the time being of the said parish of Cliffe Pypard containing by estimation Three roods and 16 and a half poles statute measure.

Pow We Robert Davis Little and Henry Weaver of Chippenham in the County of Wilts having been duly appointed Valuers to apportion the Total sum agreed to be paid by way of Rent Charge in lieu of Tithes amongst the several lands of the said parish of Cliffe Pypard **Pow** hereby apportion the Rent Charge as follows
