Other Significant Information


Emigrated to Australia in around 1911

He was buried on the 2nd May 1917 with an Anglican Service. The service was attended by one of his brothers

Probate was granted on 10th August 1917 to his brother James Bennetts Holder

Harry was awarded the British War Medal




