

William Nutley and Family

Immigrant Passengers To Australia

Barque Violet, 561 tons, Captain Henry Hall, sailed from Southampton on the 20th December 1855, arrived at Port Adelaide, South Australia on the 13th April 1856. It was the 8th ship from England to South Australia with government assisted passengers for 1856.

The Violet arrived on the 13th April with 237 immigrants; three births and six deaths occurred aboard before final disembarkation. The immigrants seemed generally a well-selected class of persons. Mr. T. R. Sumner, the surgeon-superintendent, acted very efficiently, and received every support and co-operation from Mr. Henry Hall, the master of the ship.

The 1841 census shows the Nutley family living in Collingbourne Aughton, part of Collingbourne Kingston:

William Nutley, Head, 30, Agricultural Labourer; Hannah, Wife, 30; Mary, Daughter, 11; Charles, Son, 11; George, Son, 9; James, Son, 9; Charlotte, Daughter, 6; Eunice, Daughter, 6; William, Son, Infant; Elizabeth, Mother, 60. All are recorded as born in Wiltshire.

The 1851 Census at Collingbourne Kingston records:

William Nutley, Head, 44, Agricultural Labourer; Hannah, Wife, 41, born in Barton Stacey, Hampshire; Charles, Son, 20; George, Son, 18; James, Son, 18; Eunice, Daughter, 12; William, Son, 9; Ann, Daughter, 6; Emily, Daughter, 1; Elizabeth, Mother, 70; Joseph, Brother, 42. All born in Collingbourne Kingston apart from wife Hannah.
