Fatal Accident

An inquest was held by Mr. Wilson, at the Infirmary, on the 16th instant, on the body of James Chant, aged 61, who died the previous day, in consequences of injuries sustained on the 10th of the month at Coombe Bissett, when he was knocked down by a horse and cart of which he was in charge, and the latter passed over him. Verdict, "Accidental death."
