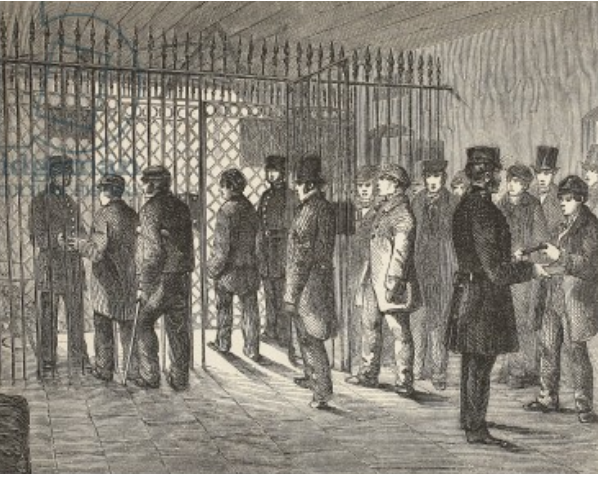

Committed To The County Gaol, Devizes for the week ending July 7, 1874 Charles Mizen, one
month, for stealing 12 sacks, the property of John Hayward, at Corsham. **The Wiltshire Independent**

Chippenham Petty Sessions, Thursday (before Rev. J. J. Daniell and Mr Clutterbuck). William
Pearce and Charles Bull, both of Corsham, quarrymen, were brought up on remand charged with stealing
on the 20th inst., a live goose, the property of Mr. James Stone, of the Manor Farm, Pickwick. There
being previous convictions against them, they were each committed for two months with hard labour.
