Elizabeth Johnson Grace fflower Mary Banning and Hannah Osborne all my Estate Goods Chattles and Monies I die possessed of both real and personal Share and Share alike I give to Samuel Neale of the City of London Carver and Builder the Sum of one Shilling Lastly I hereby nominate Constitute and appoint my said four Daughters Elizabeth Johnson Grace fflower Mary Banning and Hannah Osborne Joint Executrixes of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this twenty third Day of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and sixty nine The mark of Annamoriah Banning
