In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Hulbert of the Parish of Corsham in the County of Wilts being sick and weak yet of perfect sence and sound memory thanks be to Almighty God for it do constitute and ordaine this my last Will and Testament in manner and forme as followeth Imprimis I give and bequeath all my Goods and Chattells of what nature and kind soever to my daughter Alice Hulbert provided she doe pay my Sister Alice Power the Sume of forty shillings a yeare dureing her naturall which said forty shillings a yeare was given to her on the last will and Testament of my brother John Hulbert And I doe constitute and ordaine my said daughter Alice to be the whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament And I do nominate and appoint my Cozen Leonard Smith and my brother William Hulbert to be Trustees And I would desire them to take care and to act the best they can in making the most they can of my goods and chattells for the benefit of my said daughter Alice In Witnesse whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seale this fourteenth day of July Annoq Dm one thousand Seaven hundred and five Thomas Hulbert his marke and Seale Signed Sealed published and declared in the presence of William Hulbert his marke *John Wilsheer*
