New Harmonium for the Baptist chapel

A new Harmonium has been placed in the Baptist Chapel, and in celebration of the event, a public tea-meeting was held on Thursday. Subsequently, a public meeting was held, presided over by Mr. B. Parsons, of Warminster. The Chairman read the annual report, which stated that the expenditure during the past year (including the purchase of the a harmonium) had been £39, out of which £24 had been paid, leaving a debt of £15. The meeting was afterwards addressed by Mr. Mizen, of Sutton; Mr. Pearce, of Westbury; Mr. King, of Warminster; and Mr. Bolter, of Chapmanslade. Several pieces were sung at the harmonium. At the close, a collection was made, which realised £1 12s 10½d.
