In the name of God Amen I William Meggs of Ludwell in the parish of Donhead St. Mary in the County of Wilts Yeoman of Perfect Memory and Remembrance (praised be God) Doe make declare and ordaine this my Last Will and Testament in manner and forme following (vz)

Imprimus: I bequeath my Soule to God my Creator in soo hopes of a joyfull reserection in and through the Meritts of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ my Redeemer and my body from mitt to the earth from whence it came to be buried att the Charge & Discretion of my Executrix hereafter nominated

Item: I give unto my sonn John Meggs five pounds.

Item: I give to my sonn William Twenty Shillings.

Item: I give unto my sonn Ferdinando Meggs five shillings and I allso give unto Mary his wife five shillings.

Item: I give unto theire Three Children Elizabeth Bridgett and Judith Meggs five shillings to each of them.

Item: I give unto my Daughter Anne the Linnings and wollen that was her mothers. And allso all the rest and residue of all and singular my goods Chatles moveables monys platt houshold stuffe utentills and implements of houshold stuffe not herein or hereby dispofsed of. I give and bequeath unto my sayd Daughter Ann (my debts Legacies and funerall

expenses being payd) the sayd daughter Ann Meggs I make her my sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament revokinge all other wills and Testaments by me hereto fore made. And I doe further instruct my Loveinge friends Charles Greene of Chettle Maulter and Jeremiah Clement of Ludwell abouc[?] s[?] Pointmaker to be the Overseers of this my Last Will & Testament to see the same performed according to the intent and meanings thereof to whom I give as a token of my love five shillings apeece to buy them Gloves.

In Witnefs where of I have here unto sett my hand and Seale this ninth day of March in the Two and Twenteth yeare of the Raigne of our Soveraigne Lord Kinge Charles the Second over England Scotland France & Ireland defender of the faith And in the yeare of our Lord God one thousand Six Hundred Sixty and nine.
