

Easton Royal Holy Trinity Church Tablet to Lost Tombs and Memorials



This Tablet was raised



To keep in remembrance the names of the following persons all of whom worshipped at Easton having here their Tombs an their Memorials now lost through the decay of the old Church and Priory.

- Sir Geoffrey Esturmy Ob. 1245 and Matilda his wife
- Sir Henry Esturmy Ob. 1295 and Alina his wife
- + Henry Esturmy Ob. 1305 and Margaret his wife
- + Henry Esturmy Ob. 1338 and Matilda his wife
- Sir Henry Esturmy Ob. 1381 and Margaret his wife
- Sir William Esturmy Ob. 1427 and Joanna his wife

In Remembrance also of Sir John Seymour Ob. 1465 grandson and heir to the above Sir William and of his descendants, whose memorials likewise were suffered to fall into ruin.

All these lived nearby, latterley at Wolfhall, and were the Hereditary Wardens of the then Royal Forest of Savernake.

They were constant and generous, until the Priory's dissolution in fostering the good works of the Bretheren of Easton.

Their descendant and successor at Savernake in the year 1950 performed this duty to their Memory.
