### Thomas Gaby's Cloth Machines Destroyed

Wilts Special Commission, Salisbury, Wednesday

**Isaac Miller, Thomas Piggott, and John Romain**, were indicted for riotously assembling and destroying certain machinery used in the manufacture of cloth, the property of **Thomas Gaby**, of Figheldon.

The prosecutor stated that a mob came to his house on the 22nd of November, and destroyed several carding machines. The damage done amounted to about £150. The prisoners were identified as being among the mob.

The Jury found the prisoners Guilty.
