The only business before the Bench to-day was the hearing of several summonses for non-payment of poor-rates for the parish of Fisherton, in which the rates and costs were ordered to be paid. ## 1871

Salisbury County Petty Sessions, Tuesday before Earl Radnor and a full Bench. Henry Dismore, labourer, of Fisherton, was charged with stealing a prong, value 2s 6d, the property of Messrs Finch and Lush, of the Fisherton House Asylum. The prong was found in the prisoner's house by P.C. Hayter. He was committed for trial at the sessions, bail being accepted. Western Gazette, 8 December 1871
