Sudden death On Tuesday last an inquest was held at Fisherton Lunatic Asylum, before R. M. Wilson, Esq., on the body of Robert Evans, a criminal lunatic, who dropped down suddenly on Sunday, and expired in a few minutes. From the medical evidence it appeared that the deceased had long been afflicted with a disease of the brain. Verdict, "Died by the visitation of God."
