

Charlotte Matilda Case - Trained Nurse

Charlotte Case was born in the June quarter of 1857 in Alderbury Registration District. Census gives her birthplace as Britford.

The 1861 Census at Wadwick, Box records:-

Charlotte, 4, with her parents, Jacob, 32, a carter, and Maria, 33, older sisters Ellen 7, and Louisa 6, both born in Upton Lovell, and younger brothers, William ,2, and Frederic, 5 months.

The 1871 at Milford records:-

Matilda Case, 14, a scholar, with her parents, Jacob, 41, Maria, 42, older sister Louisa, 16, a labourer, and 6 younger brothers.

The 1881 Census at Green Croft Street, Salisbury records:-

Charlotte Matilda Case, 24, born in Britford, single, a Trained Nurse employed as a Nurse with the Roles family, and their 5 children.

In 1890 the Register of Trained Nurses 1892 and Register of Nurses (RBNA 4/1) - Royal British Nurses' Association Records, King's College London Archives gives the following entry:-

The 1891 Census for Crane Bridge Road, Fisherton Anger records:-

Charlotte M. Case, Trained Nurse, 33, single, resident, with other nurses. The Head of Household was: Anna M. Hussey, 54, single, Lady Superintendent, Nursing Institution.

OPC Note:-

Charlotte's sister Louisa also trained as a nurse.
