Hindon Petty Sessions George Allen and Henry Allen, labourers, both of Chicklade, were summoned by Mr George Kellow, agent to Alfred Morrison Esq, Fonthill Bishop, for absenting themselves from his service, they being servants in husbandry, without lawful excuse. Mr Kellow stated that this was the second time that they had absented themselves from their work. The Bench sentenced George Allen to 10 days imprisonment, and his brother Henry to 11 days imprisonment. Western Gazette Friday 28 September 1866
