The Rev. Richard Warner, Curate of St. James in Bath, is presented by Sir Harry Neale to the Rectory of Great Chalfield, in this county, vacant by the death of Rev. Clement Glynn **Salisbury and Winchester Gazette**, 24 April 1809

1857

The Rectory of Great Chalfield near Westbury in this county, is fallen vacant by the death of the Rev. Richard Warner, the incumbent, who has held the living nearly 50 years. The parish is very small having only about a population of 20 or 30 persons, and the value of the preferment rather under £200. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 6 August 1857**
