Many Bath residents will learn with regret that Major R. F. Fuller of Great Chalfield Manor, Melksham, is in Church Street Nursing Home, Bath, where he underwent an operation on Sunday. I understand that the Major is progressing satisfactorily.

Major Fuller is one of Wiltshire's best-known public men, and a member of one of the oldest West Country families. He is chairman of the Avon Rubber Co. Melksham, and a prominent agriculturist, who farms on very practical modern lines. His farm of 450 acres at Great Chalfield includes some of the finest breeds of cattle, sheep and pigs, and Mrs. Fuller co-operates with her husband in his agricultural pursuits in a very practical way. Major Fuller was president of the Bath and West Show when it was held in Trowbridge in 1937. He is a member of the Wilts County Council.
