## **Little Chalfield and Cottles**



**Little Chalfield and Cottles**, formerly extra-parochial, now form a parish in the Northern division of the county, hundred, union, petty sessional division and county court district of Bradford, 2 to 4 miles north from Bradford, about 2 from Holt station, 4 west from Melksham and 9 east from Bath.

It contains 507 acres of arable and pasture land and 57 inhabitants; rateable value, £186.

The inhabitants attend the church at Great Chalfield.

The sole landowners are George Pargiter Fuller, J.P., and Walter Spencer, esqrs.

Cottles House is the residence of Louisa Marchioness of St Agata. In the house is a chapel, which is used by Roman Catholics.

There are 240 acres of land in Cottles; rateable value, £618.
