

Spackman Famíly of Great Chalfield

The Spackman family had some success at the local agricultural shows

1862

Cheese, best loaf, not more than 6 nor less than 4 cwt – 1st, $\pounds 2/10/00$ Mr. W. Spackman **Bristol Mercury 13th December 1862**

1878

A servant of the family was a prize winner: Champion prize for ploughman having won first prize 1st Prize £3 James Davies employed by Mr. Edward Spackman, Great Chalfield (Ransome's plough) **Bristol Mercury 21 September 1878**

1880

Bull, cow and offspring – 2nd prize Mr. Edward Spackman Fat cows - 2nd prize Mr. Edward Spackman Breeding sows - 2nd prize Mr. Edward Spackman 3 acres of mangold wurzel Highly commended Mr. Spackman Bristol Mercury 15h December 1880



1880

2 acres of mangolds. 2nd prize 10s Mr. E. Spackman Bristol Mercury 10th Nov 1880

1881

Breeding sows – 1st Mr. E. Spackman Bristol Mercury 7th December 1881

1885 - Ploughing match

Champion – commended James Davis in the employ of Mr. E. Spackman, Great Chalfield Bristol Mercury 20th Oct 1885
