HARES, Charles Edwin



Charles Edwin Hares was born 1898 at Holt. He was a twin boy, his brother being James. Charles's father was Charles William Hares (1864 Holt) and mother was Rose Alice (1861 Leeds, Yorks). The boys were the 3rd and 4th children to the family, the older children being both girls. In the 1901 census the family was living in The Street, Holt close to Northfield.

Victory Medal RGA/201B/1076

British Medal RGA/201B/1076

Charles Jnr. enlisted at Trowbridge but died 4.6.1918 somewhere in France, aged 20

Charles Edwin Hares, Gunner, 170930 308th Siege Battery, Royal Garrison Artillery.

He is buried at Pernes British Cemetery, Grave Ref. VI.C.10
