Inquest Report On Thomas Chaunt

Sudden Death in a Chapel

On Monday evening week, an awful instance of sudden death occurred at the village of Homington, near Salisbury. The deceased, Thomas Chaunt, a farm labourer, was present at the service at the Primitive Methodist Chapel in that place, on that evening, when, just after the text was delivered, he was seized with a fit, and immediately expired. The deceased has left a wife and six children to deplore his loss.

An inquest was held on the following day, and the jury returned a verdict, "Died by the Visitation of God."
