## 1846

The Rev. David Malcolm, clerk, has been presented to the Rectory of Kingston Deverell, near Warminster, in this county, void by the cession of the Hon. and Rev. Lord Charles Thynne, who has been collated to a Canonry in Canterbury Cathedral. Patrons - the Most Hon. the Marchioness of Bath, and the Right Hon. Lord Ashburton, trustees of the Most Hon.
