

## Crime and Punishment

## Limpley Stoke

Whereas a petition of SETH BURGE, at present and for 5 months and upwards last past residing at Limpley Stoke, in the parish of Bradford, in the county of Wilts, carrying on the business of baker, licenced brewer, and beer retailer; previously and for eight years residing in the parish of Coomb May, in the county of Somerset, carrying on business of a baker, beer retailer, pork butcher, and bacon factor, and during the whole of the above period being a shopkeeper: - AN INSOLVENT DEBTOR – having been filed in the County Court of Wiltshire, at Bradford, and an interim order for protection from process having been given to the said Seth Burge, under the provisions of the statutes in that case made and provided, the said Seth Burge is hereby required to appear in Court, before the Judge of the said County Court of Wiltshire, on the fifteenth day of November next, at one o'clock at noon precisely, at the County Court of Wiltshire, at Bradford, for his first examination, touching his debts, estate and effects, and to be further dealt with according to the provisions of the said statutes; and Notice is hereby given, that the choice of Assignees is to take place at the time so appointed.

All persons indebted to the said Seth Burge, or who have any of his effects, are not to pay or deliver the same but to John Bush, Esquire, Church-street, Bradford, the Official Assignee acting in the manner of the said petition.
