## 1838

Death Aug. 15 at Little Hinton, Wilts, the Rev. Henry Purrier, many years rector of that parish. **Berkshire Chronicle 18 August 1838** 

Death At the rectory, Little Hinton, Wilts, aged 76, the Rev. Henry Purrier, M.M. Rector of that parish, and formerly Rector of St. Paul's, Deptford. Kentish Gazette 28 August 1838

1839

Birth Aug 19, at the Rectory, Little Hinton, Wilts, the lady of the Rev. John Harrington, a daughter. **Wiltshire Independent 29 August 1839**

Aug 13 at Bath, Mrs. Anne Purrier, relict of the Rev. Henry Purrier, late rector of Little Hinton, Wilts. Bristol Times and Mirror 26 August 1848
