James and Martha Clarke now of Hinton having lately to mitted ante nuptiall fornication are Enjoyned to Come into the parish Church of Hinton on some convenient Sunday at your discretion at ye beginning of morning prayer having White Sheets [?placuging] about them from the shoulders downwards and presently after the reading the Episile and Gospell shall make the Confession following saying after you with a loud voyce (viz)

I james and I Martha Clarke, doe here before allmightly God, and you the Congregation psent, openly acknowledge and confesse, that we have highly offended his Divine Majesty, and evill example to the neighbours, in to mitting the sin of ffornication, before our late intermarriage, and having a son borne in few weekes after; for which our grevous offence, Wee are right heartily sorry, and do unfeignedly repent thereof and doe desire God to forgive us, and doe promise never to to mitt the like offence againe: The which wee may the better performe, wee desire you to say with us the Lors prayer... Our ffather

And of the performance hereof they are to certifye under your hand unto us at Sarum at or before the last day of this instant September dates under the Seale of our office this first day of September 1713
