Long Newnton 1800-1899

The Will of the Rev. William John Bucknall Estcourt, rector of Long Newnton, Wilts, was proved by Mrs. Eleanor Lucy Estcourt, the daughter, and Brownlow Poulter, the executors, the value of the personal estate amounting to over £20,000. The testator bequeaths to his daughter £2,000 and all his plate, pictures, jewellery, household effects, carriages, and horses; and to his executor, Mr. Poulter, £100. The residue of his real and personal estate is to be held upon trust, for his daughter, for life, and then, if there are any children of her marriage, upon the trusts of her marriage settlement. **Western Gazette, 4 July 1884**
