Crockerton. The members of the Band, twelve in number, were returning, at late hour on the 2nd instant, from Evercreech club festival, when, on descending a hill, their conveyance was overturned against bank, and the whole party were thrown into the road. They were all more or less injured. The driver, a lad about 16 years of age, had his skull fractured, and, according to the latest accounts, no hopes were entertained of his recovery.
