

CORONERS INQUESTS



Inquest on Martha Ball and Francis John Ball

At Longbridge Deverill, on Martha Ball, aged 47. It appeared, from medical evidence, that the deceased was at Warminster, in her usual health, at six o'clock, pm, of the 6th inst., and died at nine o'clock the following morning of spasmodic Asiatic cholera.

Also at Longbridge Deverill, on Francis John Ball, aged one year. The deceased was son of the above, and died from Asiatic Cholera in 23 hours. The deceased also suffered from ague this season, which likewise predisposed him to this fatal disease. Verdicts in both cases: Died from Asiatic cholera.
