

Fíres Ludgershall 1800-1899

1861

A fire broke out on Tuesday afternoon, on the farm of Mr. Berry. The whole of the farm buildings and four cottages were destroyed. It is said the fire originated in the flue of one of the cottages, three of which, the property of Mr. Hutchins, were insured, but the fourth was uninsured. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal**, 8 June 1861
