Run away from Lieutenant Colonel John Bristow, of their Majesties first Regiment of Foot-Guards, the fourteenth instant, John Godfrey, and Thomas Ellison, the first a well-fit man, with brown lank hair, aged about 22, the other a middle fixed man with fair hair, aged about nineteen, both Wiltshire men, and lived near Marlborough. Whoever secures them, and gives notice of them to the above named Lieutenant-Colonel at the Officers Guard-Room in Whitehall, shall receive two Guineas Reward for each man.
