

## North Bradley Casualties of WWI

**BOX, REGINALD GEORGE -** Rifleman 6360 - 1st/12th Battalion London Regiment (The Rangers) - Died 7th October 1916 during the Battle for Ancre Heights on the Somme - Born in North Bradley; Enlisted at Trowbridge; Formerly 4415, 9th Middlesex Regiment; Son of Frederick G. and Rosina Box - Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Pier and Face 9C.

**CHAMPION, HENRY CHARLES** - Private 23762 - 6th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 7th June 1917 at Messines Ridge - Age 17 - Born in North Bradley; Resident of Trowbridge; Enlisted at Devizes; Son of Charles and Mary Champion - Buried in Klein-Vierstraat British Cemetery, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference:- II. B. 14.

**COWARD, GEORGE PERCY** - Lance Corporal 11224 - 2nd Battalion South Wales Borderers - Died 20th September 1915 - Age 19 - Born in North Bradley; Enlisted at Pontypool, Monmouthshire; Son of William and Mary Coward of 4 Kings Parade, British, Talywain, Monmouthshire - Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey - Grave/Memorial Reference: - Panel 80 to 84 or 219 and 220. Commemorated on the Pontypool and Abersychan Memorial Gates, High Street, Pontypool. Commemorated on the Noddfa Baptist Church War Memorial and the Church Roll of Honour, High Street, Abersychan.

FORD, EDWIN STEPHEN - Private 6713 - 1st Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 31st October 1914 - Age 28 - Son of Alfred Albert and Elizabeth Ann Ford of 26 Westbourne Road, Trowbridge; Husband of Sarah Ann Wicks (formerly Ford) of 15 Brewery Street, Pembroke Dock, Pembrokeshire - Commemorated on the Le Touret Memorial, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:-Panel 33 and 34 - Commemorated on the Trowbridge Town War Memorial - Commemorated on the St. Nicholas Church Roll of Honour, North Bradley (Recorded as Edward Ford) - Commemorated in the North Bradley Section of the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral, Salisbury - Commemorated in the Trowbridge (St. James) Section of the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral, Salisbury - Named in the Trowbridge and District Memorial Book 1914-1918.

**FOREMAN, JOHN JAMES** - Stoker 1st Class K/15000 - Royal Navy - H. M. S. Queen Mary - Vessel Lost at the Battle of Jutland - Died 31st May 1916 - Age 24 - Born in Crockerton, Longbridge Deverill; Son of John James and Ellen Foreman of Wood Marsh, North Bradley - Commemorated on the Portsmouth Naval Memorial, The Esplanade, Southsea, Hampshire - Grave/Memorial Reference:-Panel 18 - Commemorated on the North Bradley War Memorial. - Named in the North Bradley Section of the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book held by Salisbury Cathedral.

**LANE, ARTHUR HOWARD -** Private 3/9673 - 2nd Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 9th April 1917 - Born in Lower Studley, Trowbridge; Resident of Woodmarsh, North Bradley - Commemorated on the Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference: - Bay 7 - Commemorated on the North Bradley War Memorial - Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book held in Salisbury Cathedral.

**WILKINS, WILLIAM ALFRED G.** - Private 24136 - 1st Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 21st October 1916 during the Battle for Ancre Heights on the Somme - Born in North Bradley; Resident of Trowbridge; Enlisted at Trowbridge; Son of William and Elizabeth Wilkins - Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial Reference: - Pier and Face 13A. Commemorated in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral, Salisbury
