On Saturday the 4th inst. died, in the 66th year of his age, William. Gerrard, turner, of Pitton, in this county, greatly regretted by his family. For upwards of 35 years he was in the habit of walking (6 days in the week) from Pitton to Salisbury and back, making a distance of 10 miles per day.
