



Salisbury v Downton

SALISBURY V. DOWNTON. – On Monday last a match was played between the New Sarum and Downton Clubs, on the Salisbury Cricket Ground, being the first of the season, but from the excellent condition of the ground, we trust many other matches will soon follow. The Downton party having obtained the “toss,” sent their opponents in, when the Salisbury Club, after batting in a first-rate style gained a score of 195 runs. Welch tried his utmost, but it would not tell. Taunton also exerted himself strenuously, and deserves great praise, still it was of little avail; Shittler was then tried, and his bowling told as the score will show, The Downton eleven then took their bats, but the superior bowling of Herring and Davis put them out for the small score of 22. They then followed their innings, when after some steady play from Mr. Bracher, who scored 16 runs, their wickets were again lowered for 53 runs, making together a total of 75. The Salisbury Club thus proved themselves the victors by 120 runs in one innings. Kay and Hobbs were the umpires. The following is the score:-
