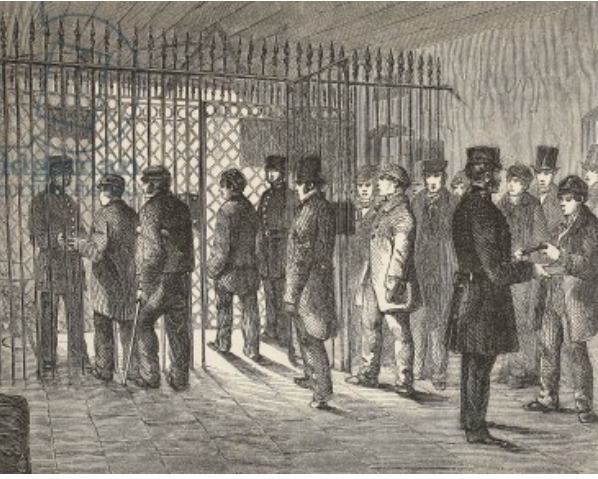

Wednesday night, about nine o'clock, as William Hayward, Salisbury carrier, was going from Bath to Holt, he was attacked between the firs at the entrance of Claverton Down, by a single footpad, armed with a cutlass, who took from him eighteen-pence in silver and some halfpence, and afterwards cut and beat him in such a barbarous manner as to endanger his life. **Hampshire Chronicle Monday 15 March 1784.**
