



Gun Stolen From Gun-Maker, Mr Rhodes' Shop

Five Guineas Reward

Lost, supposed to have been stolen, at some period between the 24th and 31st of December, 1811, from the shop of Mr. Roades, Gun-maker, Salisbury:-

A plain steel-mounted single-barrel Gun, with the Maker's Name (Rhodes) thereon.
