An inquest was held by Mr. Wilson, on the 4th instant, on the body of Charles Connor, aged 72, an old pensioner, who died on the previous morning, at his house in Love Lane, Salisbury. About seven o'clock in the morning he was observed by a neighbour leaning on the window sill, and appeared to be very ill, and almost immediately fell down by the window insensible, and expired in a quarter of an hour. Verdict, "Died by the Visitation of God."
