Salisbury. An accident occurred at the Great Western Station on Monday evening. One of the employees, named Drewitt, was assisting to push a truck when the engine attached backed some other trucks, and he was caught between the buffers. The poor fellow was taken to the Infirmary, but died before reaching it. An inquest was held on Tuesday evening. **Western Gazette, 8 October 1875**
